EARLY INTERVENTION (AHS)

The Early Intervention Program offers home-based support to families with children that have developmental delays or disabilities, aged 0-3.5 years of age. The program works with families in their natural home environments and may do a developmental screening process with the family and make referrals as needed. We work with families to find answers to their questions about their child's delay or disability and connect families to community resources and services. We give information about development, behaviour challenges, and parenting issues and will develop an individualized Family Service Plan. We support the family to plan your child's preschool years.

Speech-Language Pathology partners with families and health care providers to support children who have trouble communicating due to speech, language, social skills, communication, nonverbal communication voice, stuttering, or swallowing concerns. Occupational Therapy partners with families and health care providers to support the child's ability to participate in daily activities. Support could include helping your child in the following areas: fine motor, self regulating, feeding, toileting, equipment needs and or life skills. Physical Therapy partners with families and health care providers to support children who have trouble with movement. Support could include helping your child in the following areas: reaching their developmental milestones like rolling, crawling and walking, moving independently, head shape, balance, strength, flexibility or coordination and obtaining supportive equipment.
